

Team Ontario & Canada Soccer scouting

Playing OPDL puts your child directly on the radar of provincial and national scouts.

Ontario Soccer uses the league as its primary evaluation ground for Team Ontario selection.

Top performers are invited to identification camps and showcases. These events are stepping stones to the national program. If your child dreams of wearing the maple leaf—it starts here.

College & university recruitment (NCAA/U SPORTS)

OPDL athletes regularly move on to play at the post-secondary level. Scouts and coaches monitor league play and attend major events. We provide players with highlight reels, references, and mentorship. From U SPORTS to NCAA Division I, II, and III—opportunities are real. OPDL opens academic and athletic doors.
